HELPING HOMELESS ANIMALS

Join the WMASS team and help us raise \$15,000 or more for the homeless animals we care for until they find their new forever homes and families.

WMASS is a 100% volunteer managed and maintained facility. All funds raised support the approximately 1,000 homeless animals in our care annually. As we are a registered 501(c)(3) charity, all donations are tax deductible.

WMASS has a 90% adoption rate (the national average is under 40%).

Every animal receives a medical exam, inoculations, is tested, is spayed or neutered (if 6 months of age or older) and receives any other medical care needed. Our volunteers care for these homeless animals 365 days a year and every day each cage, kennel or cattery (where cats are free roaming) is cleaned. All our animals are well loved.

WMASS was voted as a "Must See Shelter" by the ASPCA. We have been able to upgrade our facility and provide for the animals in our care for over 40 years due to the generosity of our supporters.

Our updated facility allows most cats to live in a cage free area with an attached fenced-in and covered patio. Our dogs have interior kennels with outside access, covered exterior kennels and exercise runs on grass. There is a separate area for ill dogs and cats, an area for farm animals and an area for injured wildlife.

Fundraising is a large part of our budget. We could not provide the care we do without your support.

Donations of any size make a difference. Every \$10 raised will feed one kitten, cat or dog for two weeks.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please bring all donations, the Registration form and the First Giving form with you to the event.

Only donations received or confirmed (First Giving), alone or combined, before 3:00 pm on the day of the event will qualify for prizes.

All dogs must wear appropriate ID tags. They must be in good health and must be up-to-date on their rabies and distemper shots.

All dogs must be kept on leashes while participating in the Walk-A-Thon. Participants must clean up after their dogs.

Participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent.

Participants agree to follow all State Park rules and regulations as posted on the premises.

Participants agree not to hold the WMASS, its members, Wawayanda State Park employees or their officials liable for any injuries incurred by or to themselves, their animals, or any other persons participating before, during or after the event.

Participants give their permission for their photographs to be published at the discretion of the WMASS for publicity purposes.

WMASS and their family members are not eligible to win prizes.

In the event of a tie, the first highest total contribution received in its entirety will be deemed the winner.

Winners will be notified by telephone following the event. Participants need not be present to win. There will be no substitution of prizes.

Contest registration is free to registered walkers. For non-registered walkers, there is a \$10 suggested registration fee.
